



BUILDING AND GROUND MAINTENANCE

Background

The Division has a responsibility to protect the community's capital investment in school facilities by ensuring school buildings and grounds are adequately maintained.

Procedures

1. The Superintendent or designate is responsible for developing, implementing and management of Division's buildings and grounds.
2. Division buildings and grounds shall be maintained at a level consistent with provincial code requirements and Division standards, notably:
 - 2.1 Building exteriors shall be maintained in good repair.
 - 2.2 Grounds shall be free of hazards where possible, and
 - 2.3 Building interiors shall be clear, orderly, and free from obstructions and untidy accumulations.
3. Buildings and grounds shall be checked regularly.
4. Each year, as part of the operational planning and budgeting process, the Division will prioritize facility and grounds maintenance projects and reflect these priorities in the recommended allocation of resources for budgeting purposes.
