



SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

Background

To assist in the efficient operation of the Division and the optimal utilization of school facilities, school attendance boundaries may be established. School attendance areas will also define transportation service areas.

Procedures

1. Where school attendance boundaries have been established, a student will be directed to attend the school designated for that area.
2. In special circumstances, a Principal, in consultation with the Superintendent, may admit a resident student designated to another school attendance area, provided that there are sufficient resources and facilities at the school. In determining space availability, eligible students attending their designated school will be accommodated first.
3. When a student is admitted to a school outside of his/her designated attendance area, the parents will be responsible for transportation at their expense.
